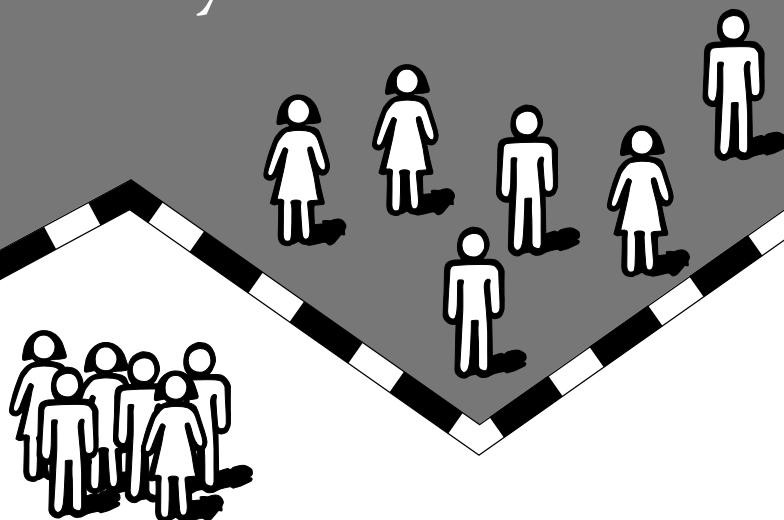


Western Australia's Proposed Electoral Boundaries May 2003



The *Electoral Distribution Act 1947* requires that Western Australia's electoral boundaries be reviewed at regular intervals so that the number of electors in each district remains within established quotients.

Following a process of obtaining written suggestions and written comments on these suggestions, the Electoral Distribution Commissioners will soon publish a booklet outlining their proposals for the electoral boundaries that will apply for the next State General Election.

The proposals booklet will be published in a special *Government Gazette* at 9am on Friday, 2 May 2003 and will also be inserted in *The West Australian* newspaper on Saturday, 3 May 2003. The booklet can also be downloaded after noon on Friday, 2 May 2003 from the Electoral Distribution website: www.boundarieswa.com.

The changes proposed may affect you at the next State General Election, so it is important that you read the information in this free booklet carefully.
