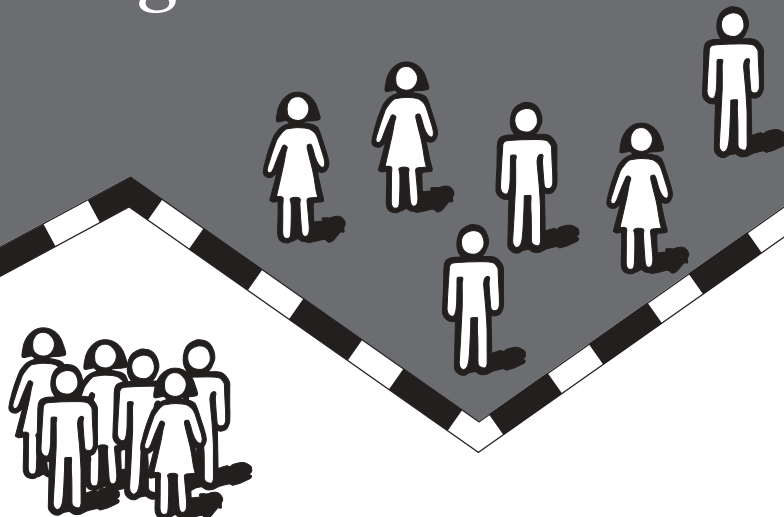


Western Australia's New Electoral Boundaries August 2003



The *Electoral Distribution Act 1947* requires that Western Australia's electoral boundaries be reviewed at regular intervals so that the number of electors in each district remains within established quotients.

Following a process of obtaining written suggestions and written comments on these suggestions, the Electoral Distribution Commissioners published their proposals for the electoral boundaries. Written objections to the proposed boundaries were then received and considered, and the Electoral Distribution Commissioners have now determined the electoral boundaries that take effect at the next State General Election.

Details of the new electoral boundaries will be published in a special *Government Gazette* at 9 am on Monday, 4 August 2003 and in a booklet inserted in *The West Australian* newspaper on Saturday, 9 August 2003. The booklet can also be downloaded after noon on Monday, 4 August 2003 from the Electoral Distribution website: www.boundarieswa.com.

The changes may affect you at the next State General Election, so it is important that you read the information in this free booklet carefully.
